

Nebraska Wesleyan University will award the **Michaela Kroft Scholarship** in the following manner:

- One \$2,000 scholarship shall be awarded for the 2020-2021 academic year.
- Eligible candidates will file the FASFA form and demonstrate financial need.
- Eligible candidates shall be in good academic standing with NWU.
- This scholarship is not renewable.
- Eligible candidates will apply for the **Michaela Kroft Scholarship** during the junior year and the scholarship will be awarded for the senior year.
- Eligible candidates must have completed at least 15 semester hours of accounting by the end of the semester in which the application is submitted with a minimum of one full-time semester remaining before graduation.
- Recipient will have a declared major in Accounting with an interest in public accounting and an intention to complete all hours necessary to sit for the CPA exam.
- Applications will include information about accomplishments, involvements, and a short essay describing why the student wants to pursue Accounting as a profession.

All students who are interested and eligible for the scholarship must submit the scholarship application and return it to **Rhonda Lakey SC240B**.
